

Terms and Conditions

- All players must be aged 16 and over.
- New players will be sent a welcome letter advising of their unique game number that has been randomly selected by secure independent computer software.
- All subscriptions received at a minimum of £1 per week payable in advance will be entered into the weekly draw using the unique draw number. The draw will normally take place each Thursday.
- All prize winners are notified by post by cheque. Weekly winning numbers are published in the local press and on our website.
- It is the responsibility of the player to advise us of any change of address or any other membership details deemed necessary.
- Accepted payment methods can be Cash, Standing Order, and Cheque.
- We promise to comply with all Data Protection Act requirements and protect your personal data. It would be appreciated by members that Willowbrook Hospice cannot accept liability for the loss or delays in or theft of any communication sent neither by post, email or fax, nor for any delays in the banking system.
