

Monthly Giving helps to support your local hospice plan for the future.

You already know about the wonderful care that our patients can expect when they come to Willowbrook Hospice.

We help people make the most of precious moments – when every moment counts.

We help more than 1100 people a year who have life limiting illnesses such as cancer and motor neurone disease. We provide specialist medical care on our inpatient unit, outpatient appointments, physiotherapy, and complementary therapy to patients and families.

We do not charge for our services, but there is a cost.

We want to be sure that this service is freely available to as many local people as possible, and so we work hard to raise the **£10,000 a day** required to provide the specialist care that local people need.



We receive around one third of our funding from local healthcare providers, but almost £2 million is donated by people in our community... people just like you.

Why do we need monthly gifts?

Monthly Giving is one of the most powerful and effective ways to support your local hospice, and benefits us all.

You give simply, easily and conveniently and we receive secure monthly income to ensure continued delivery of programmes and services at no cost at all to our patients.



Can you afford just 33p a day?

Your commitment to Willowbrook Hospice through regular donations will add up to a significant contribution over a manageable period of time.

For example...

£10 a month is only 33 pence a day, but adds up to £120 a year! This could provide wine and sherry offered to the patients to enhance their appetite.

£25 a month is only 83 pence a day, but adds up to £300 a year! This could provide several complementary therapy sessions for our patients.

£50 a month is only £1.65 a day, but adds up to £600 a year! This will help to pay for patient lunches.
